

2020 Miami County 4-H Trip Scholarship Information

To be eligible for opportunities listed below, members must complete a Miami County 4-H Resume and participate in an interview. Resumes must be submitted to the Extension Office by 4:00 p.m., Friday, February 7, 2020. Interviews will be held Tuesday, February 11, 2020, beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the Hayner Cultural Center. Please rank each opportunity in which you are interested and contact the Extension Office to schedule an interview. Interviews are by appointment only. Trip scholarships are sponsored by the 4-H Advisory Committee of Miami County unless indicated.

____ **Buckeye Leadership Workshop** (16 & older) – Participants are encouraged and empowered to experiment with new activities, develop new abilities, discover new interests, expand their creativity, practice and master new leadership skills, share ideas and personal skills, establish new friendships, and develop networks of human resources. This event will be held **March 25 - 29, 2020**, at Recreation Unlimited Camp in Ashley, Ohio. **One full scholarship is available.**

____ **Ohio 4-H State Leadership Camp** - This camp will be held **June 1 - 5, 2020**, at Camp Ohio in St. Louisville, OH. The focus of this program is the development of concrete peer leadership skills that will enable participants to have an immediate impact in their home 4-H club, county, community, or school. Scholarships are partially funded by Nationwide and Farm Credit Mid-America. **Two full scholarships are available.**

____ **Camp Canopy** (formerly known as Forestry & Wildlife Conservation Camp) - This camp will be held **June 7 - 12, 2020**. It is offered annually at FFA Camp Muskingum. Situated on Leesville Lake in the beautiful rolling hills of Carroll County, campers have the opportunity to learn first-hand about Ohio's forests and natural resources. **One full scholarship is available.**

____ **Citizenship Washington Focus** – This unique program will be held **June 21 - 27, 2020**, at the National 4-H Center in Washington, D.C. Through sightseeing tours in the living classroom of Washington, D.C. and hands-on educational workshops, youth will learn about the history of our nation, the leaders who have shaped it and how they can apply the leadership and citizenship skills they have learned at CWF when they return home. **One partial scholarship is available.**

____ **Senior Ohio 4-H Shooting Education Camp** – This camp will be held **July 19 - 24, 2020**, at Canter's Cave 4-H Camp in Jackson, OH. Activities focus on the safe, responsible, and ethical use of firearms and archery equipment. **One full scholarship is available.**

____ **Ohio 4-H Sea Camp** – This camp will be held **July 11 - 15, 2020**. Experience Lake Erie-based activities and culture such as aquatic science, water recreation, and fishing at Kelley's Island 4-H Camp on Lake Erie. **One full scholarship is available.**

____ **Ohio 4-H Conference** (13 and older) - This event will take place on **March 14, 2020**, at the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Attendees will have the opportunity to receive training in more than 125 different topics such as career exploration, camping, leadership, cake decorating, dancing, animal sciences, and more. **Four full scholarships are available.**
