Applications for state and national 4-H trips are now available for youth ages 14-18 (as of Jan. 1, 2016). Trip applicants need only submit a “resume” and interview. [See resume format and trip descriptions.](#) Resumes are due Monday, January 25. Interviews are 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 28, in the Extension Meeting Room.

Members who are at least age 12 (as of Jan. 1, 2016) or older, have been enrolled in 4-H for at least two consecutive years, and have previously completed (or will be enrolled in 2016) at least one FCS project, are eligible to apply for the 2016 Food & Fashion Board.
