

- Cost: Cost per camper will not exceed \$450. Based on optional activities and changes in our potential schedule, the
  cost per camper may be lower than initially budgeted. Any camper who is enrolled in 4-H can attend for a discounted
  rate of \$400/camper
- Registration: Pre-registration is due by May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024




