

Backyard Poultry Certification Course

Interest in keeping backyard poultry has been increasing steadily as more and more people want to provide for their family and personal food security. We have also seen an increase in youth keeping backyard chickens or turkeys for 4H livestock projects.

Whatever your reason for raising poultry, this course is designed to provide you with the knowledge and resources you will need to get your backyard flock off to a great start.



This self-paced course is expected to take **2-3** hours to complete and includes these **6 modules**:

- Getting Started
- Brooding, Basic Husbandry & Nutrition
- Housing
- •Egg Production
- •Maximizing Health
- Biosecurity

Course cost = \$25

After completing this course, learners will be able to:

- •Identify rules and regulations relevant to raising backyard poultry.
- •Source healthy birds to raise in their backyard
- •Apply concepts of basic husbandry, nutrition, and housing of poultry.
- Explain how eggs are produced
- •Practice safe handling of birds and eggs
- •Recognize common health-related abnormalities of poultry
- •Describe the roles of veterinary care and biosecurity in poultry health There are NO refunds issued for this course.

Horse only Quality Assurance Dates:

Quality Assurance (QA) and registration sessions for horses - Miami County Fair 2024

Every member who is going to show a horse at the Miami County Fair will need to attend one of the following sessions (there will be no exceptions).

Date 1- Tuesday March 26th 6PM-8:30PM

Date 2- Wednesday April 24th 6PM-8:30PM

Date 3- Sunday May 19th 6PM-8:30PM

The QA sessions will be held at the Duke Building.

Deadline to add entries or project changes will remain June 1st. Late changes will be accepted up until June 9th with a \$50 late fee.

Each member and a parent will need to attend and bring the following documents with them (please have 3 copies – one for you, one for your advisor and one for Fair Board):

- Equistep Certificate
- Coggins Test (dated after January 1st, 2024, must be the test results that includes pictures of the horse)
- If leasing a horse, you will need a copy of the lease along with the completed horse ID form
- Please bring a laptop or your phone to complete registration

During this session, you will also choose the classes that you will show in at our Fair. Advisors and Fair Board members will be present to help you choose appropriate classes.

Each member and parent will also attend the following 15-20 minute informational sessions:

- 1) Horse health
- 2) Proper tack and clothing (if you have specific tack and clothing questions, bring them with you so we can help)!
- 3) Show etiquette and what a judge looks for in the show ring
- 4) 2024 rule changes, safety and barn rules
- 5) Fair class registration

Save the Date for Ohio 4-H Sea Camp

- Dates: July 19-23, 2024. Full time attendance is required.
- Cost: Cost per camper will not exceed \$450. Based on optional activities and changes in our potential schedule, the cost per camper may be lower than initially budgeted. Any camper who is enrolled in 4-H can attend for a discounted rate of \$400/camper
- Registration: Pre-registration is due by May 1st, 2024
