QUALITY ASSURANCE

The Ohio Department of Agriculture mandates Quality Assurance (QA) for all youth exhibitors (age 8-18) of market and lactating dairy animals. The ODA requires QA to be completed a minimum of 45 days prior to exhibition. Quality Assurance for 2021 must be completed by June 1, 2021. VIRTUAL SKILLATHONS

Miami County 4-H members enrolled in animal projects must complete a skillathon for each animal project area (excluding cats, llamas, alpacas, and cavies) in which they are enrolled. Members may complete skillathons online **May 1 - June 1, 2021**. The categories will be divided by animal project area and age level of members (as of January 1): Juniors, ages 8 (and in 3rd grade) - 11; Intermediate, ages 12 - 14; Seniors, ages 15-18. PROJECT ENROLLMENT FOR OHIO STATE FAIR

4-H members must be enrolled in their county in any project they enter to show in the Ohio State Fair Junior Livestock Shows (including poultry, rabbits, and dogs), regardless of whether that project is offered for county exhibition (Source: *Family Guide*, pg. 4).

The **Miami County 4-H Add/Drop project deadline is May 1**. All project changes must be submitted in writing. Please email Connie at veach.7@osu.edu for project changes (Ex. I would like to add project 140, Swine Breeding). If adding a livestock project, please also send a copy of the Ohio Revised Code Livestock Standards Acknowledgement.
