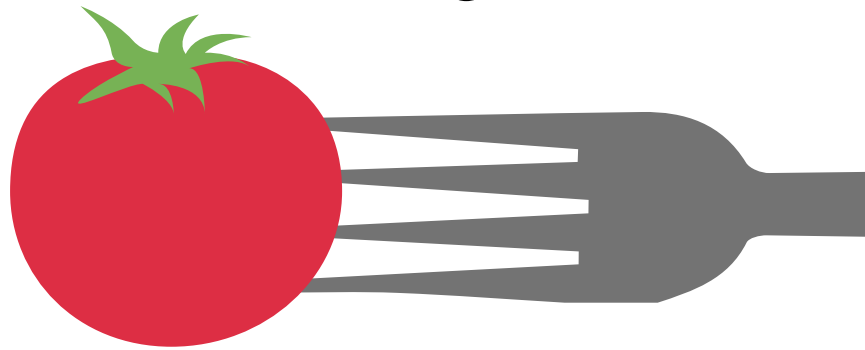


MIAMI COUNTY MASTER GARDENER VOLUNTEERS PRESENT
